- [Saskatchewan Immunization Manual](#) – the primary immunization resource for health care providers. General information about vaccination principles and vaccines, immunization schedules. Similar to the Canadian Immunization Guide, but Saskatchewan specific.
- [Saskatchewan COVID-19 Immunization Manual](#) – information for all health care providers supporting COVID-19 immunization in the province. Includes Health Professional Resources for COVID-19 Vaccine Contraindications and Precautions Background Document, important communication from Ministry of Health (e.g. letters from Dr. Shahab). Note that there are work standards for Saskatchewan Health Authority clinics on this site and pharmacies may find the DPEBB website easier to navigate for pharmacy specific procedures.
- [Saskatchewan COVID-19 Situation Reports \(CRISP\)](#) - These bi-weekly reports highlight COVID-19, influenza, RSV, and other respiratory illness activity in Saskatchewan. Helpful to understand risk of exposure when making clinical decisions.
