**BEYOND-USE  
EXPIRY  
DATE/TIME:<sup>^</sup>**

- Check date on label (expiry date)
- 2°C to 8°C: use vaccine until expiry date.

<sup>^</sup> PM includes excursion data.



**HANDLING:**

- **SHAKE WELL** before administration to re-suspend.



**APPEARANCE:**

- Slightly opaque, white suspension
- NO foreign particulate matter/discolouration



**DOSE:**

- 0.5 mL (25 U)



**SERIES/SCHEDULE:**

- 1-dose with a booster: 0, 6 to 18 months

\* Pharmacists can immunize those 5 years and older.
